Finance Director's Annual Report 2021

My full report can be found [here](#) but the key highlights are:

- Hampshire Ladies Golf Ltd Company made a surplus of £1,100 compared to a budgeted loss of £10,000;
- Total capital and reserves is now £66,435;
- Spending was generally lower than expected;
- Entry fees for competitions to be increased to £32.50 per head;
- A HLG Finance and Budgeting Governance Document and a HLG Expenses Policy Document can be viewed on the HLG website [here](#)
- There is a proposal to increase Affiliation fees from £5 per head to £6 per head in **2023** or from £5 per head to £7 per head in 2023 if Hampshire Golf (men) approve the inclusion of a County Card within the affiliation fees.

- Despite the ongoing pandemic in 2021, we managed to host 15 HLG competitions this year from May to October and over 500 ladies competed in these events (but down by around 200 participants from 2019);

- A massive thanks to all the clubs who hosted our HLG events this year and to all the volunteers who so generously gave their time.
