CENTENARY FOURSOMES TROPHY

(Presented by Hampshire, IOW & CI Golf Union in 2000 - HLCGA's Centenary Year)

1. A Foursomes Stableford competition played for annually over 18 holes.
2. The competition is open to all Hampshire affiliated clubs. Each club shall hold a qualifying Foursomes Stableford competition, the winners going forward to the final and the second placed pair to be the reserves.
3. There shall be no competition unless 10 or more clubs enter.
4. WHS Regulations apply, Combined Handicap Index limit is 72.0, at time of entry. Handicap allowance shall be $\frac{1}{2}$ the combined Course Handicaps, rounded up.
5. Caddies are permitted and are the responsibility of their player. Caddies must not become involved in disputes between players and they are requested not to go on to the greens. No professional golfer can caddy.
6. The team returning the highest Stableford score shall win the Trophy.
7. In the event of a tie there will be a card count-back on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes.
8. The winning club shall hold the Centenary Foursomes Trophy for one year. The winning and second placed clubs will receive vouchers. Further vouchers will be awarded in proportion to the number of entries.
