Responsibilities:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attend EG General Meetings two times a year and an Annual General Meeting (AGM); the latter is usually held at same time as one of the General Meetings Receive and report any relevant EG communications to the HLG Board and Club Delegates, as required; receive and report any HLG issues or concerns to EG Where appropriate, seek the mandate of HLG members and vote accordingly at EG General Meetings or AGM; be accountable to HLG Act at all times in the best long-term interests of EG and golf in England

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possess a working knowledge of EG and its priorities; understand the needs and priorities of the County they represent Have well-developed communication skills and the ability to assimilate detailed information quickly Ability to work as part of a team; actively engage with other VMRs to understand the issues across the country and in all parts of the game Commit to EG/HLG's values (Be Honest, Inclusive, Responsible, Excellent and Supportive) Be able to commit the time necessary to fulfil the VMR role, as required
